PASTEL PAPERS

- Canson pastel paper, 1 sheet of each color:
 - Light or gray blue
 - Wave or pottery green
 - Light gray
 - AND/OR Sanded pastel papers - UART or other

PASTELS - RECOMMENDED

- Nupastels: 24-36 stick set
- Rembrandt or other soft pastels 15-30 half sticks
- Bring any other dry pastels you may have
