Please bring to the first class:

- A piece of felt or a small white/ivory woolen blanket (about 24"x20"), typically available at JoAnn Fabrics or Walmart. If unsure, we have enough for you to use in class.
- You may bring your own sumi ink stick, brushes, and sumi paper if you already own them.
 Some of the basic materials such as paper, ink, brush, and paint will be provided for classroom use.
- If you wish to buy your own brush, it will be available for purchase during class (\$20).
- Sumi ink and paint are available at Blick Art Materials.
- Paper: You will receive 10 sheets to use on the first day of class. After that you will need to bring your own paper. It is available to <u>order from Amazon</u>. Please get 50cm x 100cm size.
 - O There are 100 sheets in a package. Feel free to coordinate and share the cost with a classmate after the first session. It usually ships quickly. Keep in mind that you may use about 10-15 sheets each week.

Supplies provided by MIAD:

- 10 sheets of paper
- Ink and brushes to be used during class
- Felt blankets, ink dish, and other miscellaneous supplies
