The first project we will make is the Dragon from <u>This Simplicity Pattern</u>. You may purchase the pattern ahead of time, but MIAD will have one that we can share as a class.

## Please bring to the first class:

- 1/2 yard of 45" or 60" wide fabric for the body of the dragon
- 3/8 yard of 45" or 60" wide fabric for the front of the body
- 3/8 yard of 45" or 60" wide fabric for the wings of the dragon
- 5/8 yard of Fusible Web Interfacing such as Heat n' Bond or Wonder Under Universal thread, 100% Polyester
- Fiber fill (or a creative alternative!)
- Fabric scissors
- Thread snips
- Pencil and eraser

You can purchase these things brand new from a store with sewing supplies like JoAnn, Walmart, Fischberger's Variety (local option) or bring fabric from your personal collection.

## Supplies provided by MIAD:

- Tracing paper
- Bobbins, thread
