**Please bring to the first class:**

- Poster board or equivalent sturdy material, minimum size of 18 x 24 inches
- Glue stick
- Graphite Pencils (mechanical pencils permitted)
- Scissors
- Permanent Markers (OPTIONAL)
- Sketchbook of any size or paper type
  - (can be one you already use - this will be necessary for sketching/thumbnailing exercises)
- Paint\*
  - You are welcome to use oil or acrylics. If you are comfortable with painting choose your preferred media. If you are new to painting I highly suggest acrylic paint.
  - Palette must include at least White, Red, Yellow, and Blue paint
- Set of Paint Brushes\*
  - Blick sells many acrylic variety brush packs, these are a great affordable option with size variation
- Paint Palette\*
- One Canvas of at least 18 x 24 inches\*
