- 18" x 24" Bond drawing pad
- (1) Roll of painter's tape, drafting tape, or masking tape
- Charcoal pencils: HB, 1H, or 2H (1 or 2, your choice of hardness)
- Compressed charcoal: 2B, 4B, 6B (2 of each suggested)
- Willow charcoal/vine charcoal
- Conte Crayons: (1) sanguine, (1) sepia, (1) black, (1) white
- (1) Gum eraser
- (1) Kneaded eraser
- (1) Plastic eraser
- (1) Chip brush or Hake brush, 1" or 2" wide
- (1) Reed pen
- (2) Sumi brushes, two different sizes (small and wide)
