- 5+ garments or textile home goods to reclaim for your quilt top. These items should be woven, like a tablecloth or a button up shirt. They do not need to be in pristine condition. No upholstery fabric and nothing stretchy (no t-shirts)
- Notebook and writing utensil
- Rotary cutter and/or fabric shears (also available in the Textiles Lab)

Supplies provided by MIAD:

- Hidamari Sashiko needles
- Glass tipped straight pins
- Basting pins
- Thimble

Note from the instructor: We will go over reclaiming fabric in the first class, so it's okay if you're not sure what will work best before then. Some supplemental fabric will be provided as well.
