#### Paints in 5 ml or 14 ml tubes. Winsor Newton, Blick, or another preferred brand.

- Auerolin Yellow, Hansa Yellow or Cadmium Yellow Lemon
- Cadmium Yellow Medium or New Gamboge Yellow
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue or Cobalt Blue
- Alizarin Crimson permanent or Quinacradone rose
- Cadmium Red Light or Naphol Red
- Winsor Green (Thalo green) or Viridian
- Sap Green
- Cadmium Orange or other orange
- Violet

Earth pigments (required)

- Burnt Sienna semitransparent
- Raw Sienna semitransparent or Yellow Ochre
- Raw Umber

## Paper

Cold pressed 140 lb watercolor paper

• 12" x 18" or 18" x 24" 30 sheet pad – Arches, Canson, Strathmore or Blick brand

## **Brushes & Palette**

- (1) #1 or #2 small round watercolor brush
- (1) #8 or larger round watercolor brush
- (1) 1" flat, wash brush
- Plastic palette with wells and a lid

Unless specified, most class supplies may be purchased at Blick Art Materials. Blick is located across the street from MIAD, 242 E. Menomonee St. Milwaukee, WI 53202.

## Other items

- (2) Water containers plastic, at least 10 oz.
- Paper towels
