Embedding Materials

If you are interested in embedding things in your paper (flower petals, thread, etc etc.) You will be responsible for providing those. If you are unsure what this means, we will talk about this process on day one – and you will have a chance to practice it on day two.

MOST IMPORTANT:

Papermaking is a very clean – but very wet process. If you get pulp on your clothes or arms, it is washed away easily.

- Wear clothing that can get wet. Bring an apron if you like (this will likely get wet as well).
- Wear shoes that have closed toes they may get wet as well (Crocs or not your best tennis shoes) work well.
- Hair should be tied back and leave the jewelry at home!
