- Instructor will provide the palette knives, but feel free to bring your own or purchase a few to practice at home!
- Palette a large flat surface works best such as a plexi glass, paper plates, or freezer paper works as well
- Jar for water or medium
- A small spray bottle
- Paper towel or cotton rags
- Acrylic paint, 5 oz tube or larger
 - Recommended colors:
 - o Cadmium red
 - Quinacridone red
 - Cadmium yellow
 - o Pthalo blue
 - Ultramarine blue
 - o Titanium white
 - Other colors optional
- 6 canvases, stretched or panel, 11" x 14" or larger recommended (at least one per week)
- Optional:
 - Photographs to work from
 - A large cardboard box or painting case for transport (MIAD cannot store wet paintings)

Supplies provided by MIAD:

- Easels and stools
- Some paper towels available in classroom
