Please bring to the first class:

Suggested drawing media below. Students are welcome to use their preferred value-based, dry drawing media. Full-class poses and two-class-session poses provide opportunities to develop drawings on larger format paper.

Required:

- Drawing paper pad, 18 x 24 in. - approx. 80 lb. or higher paper weight
- Kneaded eraser - large - one minimum
- Prismacolor Ebony pencil
- Charcoal
 - Vine sticks
 - Compressed pencils and/or sticks
- Container to hold drawing materials
- Portfolio or folded cardboard to transport paper and drawings

Optional, in recommended order:

- White Charcoal sticks and/or pencils
- Toned drawing paper sheets or pad (blue, tan, cream, etc.)
- Larger sizes of quality drawing paper such as 22 x 30 in., 24 x 36 in.
- conté - pencils or sticks - black and/or red + white

Nice to have:

- Sketchbook for notes and thumbnails
- Large bulldog clips and/or spring clamps to hold larger paper
- Blue painter's tape to temporarily affix paper to drawing boards

Supplies provided by MIAD:

Easels, drawing horses, stools, and some drawing boards in various sizes.
